




Shrimad Rajchandra Animal Nursing Home

Shrimad Rajchandra Animal Nursing Home is the first of its kind medical facility for animals and birds in rural South Gujarat, providing quality treatment free or at highly subsidised costs to animal owners and farmers.







Shrimad Rajchandra Mobile Veterinary Service

Under this initiative, over 220 villages in South Gujarat and over 100km are covered. 61,000 cases have been treated thus far.

Shrimad Rajchandra Mobile Veterinary Service provides preventive, first-aid and medical treatment to animals at their doorstep.

The facilities provided include vaccination, deworming, nutritional supplements and hormone therapy. They also perform minor surgeries. However, when major surgery is required, the animal is referred to and transported to appropriate animal hospitals.





Shrimad Rajchandra Cattle Rehabilitation Programme

To help reduce the burden on animal sanctuaries and provide assistance to local farmers, Shrimad Rajchandra Cattle Rehabilitation Programme helps to match healthy cattle with farmers who could use the cattle for ploughing fields and other activities, while the cattle get a safe home.

Shrimad Rajchandra Animal Helpline

Shrimad Rajchandra Animal Helpline is a dedicated contact number and ambulance to help save the lives of sick and injured stray animals and birds in Mumbai. This helpline provides an organised platform to report animal cruelty and injuries so that animals in pain receive timely and adequate support.

Under this initiative, 22,795 stray animals have been treated on the roads of Mumbai since 2016.




Heartwarming Stories of Recovery

An Ox with 4th Degree Horn Cancer

In the Bhensdara village of rural South Gujarat, doctors of Shrimad Rajchandra Animal Nursing Home treated an ox with pus near its horn. The doctors subsequently diagnosed horn cancer, a highly painful disease. After a successful surgical amputation of the horn, the ox recovered completely.








A Turtle with a Fractured Shell

A turtle crushed by a tractor near Dharampur was immediately brought to Shrimad Rajchandra Animal Nursing Home for treatment. The medical team diagnosed the turtle with a fracture in its shell and sedated it to prevent further pain. The team used a wiring technique to repair the fragmented shell. The team closely monitored the turtle for one month at the nursing home and rehabilitated it back to its habitat.





































Pujya Gurudevshri Rakeshji inspired the creation of a 360-degree model programme to foster animal bonding and extend love and sensitivity towards all beings.
